

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FULTON COUNTY GAMING
ORDINANCE OF 2017

WHEREAS the Fulton County Board enacted the Fulton County Gaming Ordinance on August 8, 2017 pursuant to Illinois Law, and

WHEREAS, 230 ILCS 40/25(e) as originally written allowed a licensed establishment to operate up to 5 video gaming terminals on its premises at any time, and

WHEREAS, 230 ILCS 40/25(e) was amended by Public Act 101-031 to allow a licensed establishment to operate up to 6 video gaming terminals on its premises at any time, and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Gaming Ordinance as originally written allowed a licensed establishment to operate up to 5 video gaming terminals on its premises at any time, and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board wishes to amend the Fulton County Gaming Ordinance to allow for 6 video gaming terminals at a licensed establishment as provided for by 230 ILCS 40/25(e) as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF FULTON THAT § 2(C)(7) OF THE FULTON COUNTY GAMING ORDINANCE OF 2017 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 2(C)(7)


Notwithstanding any greater limit which may from time to time be established by the Illinois Legislature, no more than six (6) video gaming terminals shall be allowed, nor permits be issued therefor, under this Ordinance for each licensee at any one location.
