ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of August, 1992, the Fulton County Board adopted an Ordinance which provided for emergency ambulance service to the citizens of Fulton County, Illinois; and,


WHEREAS, it appears necessary to amend the aforesaid Ordinance as previously amended to provide for the fixing of charges for ambulance services in the Fulton County Ambulance Service Area effective September 1, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed fee schedule which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, appears appropriate and reasonable.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED, by the Fulton County Board as follows:

1. That the schedule of fees submitted by the Fulton County Emergency Medical Association effective September 1, 2012, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby approved effective September 1, 2012.
2. That each Fulton County Emergency Medical Association, Inc., ambulance at the scene of an emergency and during the transport of emergency patients to and between hospitals will be staffed at the level of life support as required and licensed by the Illinois Department of Public Health.
3. That all other terms and conditions of the August 11, 1992 Ordinance, and otherwise as amended in regard to emergency ambulance service to the citizens of Fulton County shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this Ordinance in regard to the attached schedule of fees.
