FULTON COUNTY RESPONSIBLE BIDDER ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR THE DETERMINATION OF A RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR COUNTY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes, including the Illinois Counties Code, regulate purchases and contracts entered into by the County of Fulton; and

WHEREAS, such Statutes grant to the County the authority and discretion to determine what constitutes a "responsible bidder" and it is deemed necessary and advisable to establish criteria to better enable the corporate authorities of the County to determine who constitutes a "responsible bidder" for County public works projects such as construction of new municipal facilities, renovation of existing facilities and road and utility construction projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fulton County Board of the County of Fulton, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1:

In determining which bidder is a "responsible bidder" on County public works projects, over \$100,000.00, the bidder must comply with the following criteria, and submit acceptable evidence of such compliance, in addition to any other requirements as determined from time to time by the County for the specific type of work to be performed:

- The bidder must comply with all applicable laws concerning the bidder's entitlement to conduct business in Illinois.
 - (2) The bidder must comply with all applicable provisions of the Prevailing Wage Act.
 - (3) The bidder must comply with Subchapter VI ("Equal Employment Opportunities") of Chapter 21 of Title 42 of the United States Code (42 U.S.C. 2000e and following) and with Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375.
 - (4) The bidder must have a valid Federal Employer Identification Number or, if an individual, a valid Social Security Number.
 - (5) The bidder must have a valid certificate of insurance showing the following coverages: general liability, professional liability, product liability, workers' compensation, completed operations, hazardous occupation, and automobile.
 - (6) The bidder and all bidder's subcontractors must participate in applicable apprenticeship and training programs approved by and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training.

SECTION 2:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law ..
