FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

From the Office of the Chief County Assessment Officer:

“If your dwelling or any other taxable structures were rendered uninhabitable, damaged or destroyed during the storms that impacted Fulton County on March 31st, 2023 or April 4th, 2023, you are entitled to a pro-ration/reduction of the assessed value on those affected structures for the 2023 assessment year. **This pro-ration/reduction will affect the taxes paid in 2024.**

Forms are being mailed out to the affected property owners that we have record of. To see if you are on that list, please call (309) 547-3041 and ask for the Assessment Office. The “**PTAX-761 Request for Reduction Due to Destruction**” form is also available on the front page of our website and under “Forms” on the Assessment Office page.

Pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/9-180, affected property owners have until **Wednesday, July 5th, 2023** (90 Days) to return the forms to the Fulton County Assessment Office. Forms received after this date will result in the property being re-evaluated for the 2024 assessment year, taxes payable in 2025.
